POPIA

This Notice explains how we obtain, use and disclose your personal information, in accordance with the requirements of the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2008 ("POPIA").

About the Company

The information we collect

We collect and process your personal information mainly to contact you for the purposes of understanding your requirements, delivering of services accordingly, and billing.

We collect information directly from you where you provide us with your personal details. Where possible, we will inform you what information you are required to provide to us and what information is optional.

Website usage information may be collected using "cookies" which allows us to collect standard internet visitor usage information.

How we use your information

We will use your personal information only for the purposes for which it was collected and agreed with you. In addition, where necessary your information may be retained for legal or research purposes.

For example:

Disclosure of information

Information Security

Your Rights: Access to information

Correction of your information

You have the right to ask us to update, correct or delete your personal information. We may require proof of authority before making changes to personal information we may hold about you. We would appreciate it if you would keep your personal information accurate.

Destruction or deletion of Personal Information

You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information after 60 months. We will however remove any personal information after 60 months once the account has been closed; Digital information will be removed from the Database, from the storage environment. Any hard copies/documents we may hold will be shred before discarding. Backup of digital information will remain for a period of 360 days before recycling of backup information.

Definition of Personal Information

According to the Act "personal information" means information relating to an identifiable, living, natural person, and where it is applicable, an identifiable, existing juristic person. Further to the POPI Act, Traffic Expert Solutions (Pty) Ltd also includes the following items as personal information:
